



EVENT BOOKING TERMS

The Boot Scooting Society · For the line dancing curious

These terms cover a boot scooting session run by The Boot Scooting Society (Kirsten Mann, ABN 98 897 963 166). Your booking is confirmed once full payment has been received. By making payment, you also confirm that you have read and accepted these terms.

1. What we provide

We provide a facilitator to teach and run a boot scooting session for your group. Everyone starts as a beginner, so no experience is needed. A session usually runs 45 to 60 minutes unless we agree otherwise.

2. The venue is booked separately

You book and pay the venue directly. We are not the venue operator. We are not responsible for the venue, its facilities, food, drinks, staff, or its terms. Any minimum spend, room hire, catering and alcohol service are matters between you and the venue.

3. Sound and microphone

We need a speaker or PA that accepts two inputs at once:

- One line for music, connected to a phone (3.5mm cable or Bluetooth).
- One line for a wireless microphone.

If your venue can provide this, please confirm it before the event. If it cannot, we can supply a suitable speaker and microphone for an additional fee, quoted and agreed before the event.

4. Fees and payment

The facilitation fee is as quoted for your event. A travel fee of \$150 applies if the venue is more than 25 minutes from the Melbourne CBD.

- Your date is secured once your payment is received.
- Payment is by bank transfer to the account shown on your invoice.
- The Boot Scooting Society is registered for GST. GST applies to all fees and is itemised on your tax invoice.

5. Your guests, alcohol and safety

Boot scooting is a physical activity. Guests take part voluntarily and to the level of their own comfort and ability.

You are responsible for the conduct of your guests, including any guest affected by alcohol. Where alcohol is served, it is served by the venue under the venue's own responsible service of alcohol obligations, not by us.

For everyone's safety, we may ask a guest who is intoxicated or behaving unsafely to sit out. You are responsible for any loss, injury or damage caused by your guests' conduct, including slips from spilt drinks or one guest injuring another.

We run every session with reasonable care and skill. Nothing in these terms limits any rights you have under the Australian Consumer Law that cannot be excluded.

6. Photography

We may take photos or video during the session for The Boot Scooting Society's own promotion. If a guest would prefer not to appear, let us know on the day and we'll keep them out of shot.

7. Changes and cancellation

- Full payment is required to confirm your booking and reserve the agreed date and time.
- If you need to move your event, we will do our best to accommodate a new date, subject to availability. Your payment can be transferred to one new date by agreement.
- If you cancel:
 - more than 2 months before your event, your payment will be refunded in full, less any costs already committed specifically for your booking.
 - Less than 2 months before your event, your payment is non refundable. Event dates are typically booked several months in advance and, at this point, it is unlikely we can replace your booking.
- If Boot Scooting Society has to cancel and we cannot agree on a suitable alternative date, your payment will be refunded in full.
- Any cancellation or change relating to your venue is separate and is governed by your agreement with the venue.

Acceptance

Making the payment confirms that you have read and agreed to these terms on behalf of the client organisation. No signature is required.
